EATING OUT

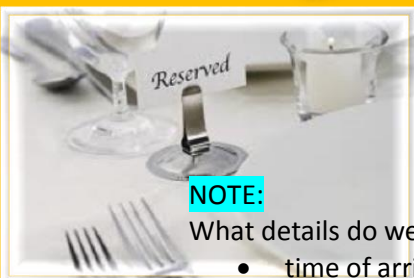
SELF SERVICE / CANTEEN

- take a tray, cutlery
 - o spoon
 - o fork
 - o knife
- pay the dishes at the cash desk
- find a seat
- take back the tray and the leftover



BUFFET, PIZZA HUTS, GYROS BARS

- queue up
- pay for the dishes
 - o sandwich
 - o pizza
 - o gyros
- you can sit to eat the food
- you can take it away

- time of arrival
- how many people arrive
- where to want to sit (next to the window/in a box)
- special needs (having allergy/diabetes/being vegetarian; celebrating and asking for fancy cake)
